- ➔ Helping people to stay in their homes.

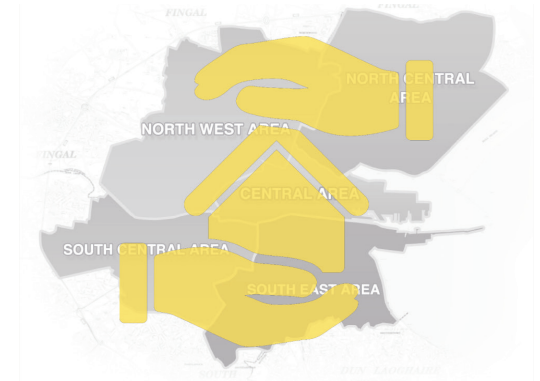
