WHAT AN IMPACT YOU'VE HAD

Homelessness is already incredibly tough – but for so many, it also brings addiction and mental health struggles.

So in 2012, we started Sure Steps. The idea was beautifully simple: no matter where people find themselves, they should be listened to, supported, and helped find a way forward.

Everyone walking through our door tells a unique story - and our counsellors take time to genuinely hear and respond to it. We started with two part-time volunteers. Today, 20 counsellors bring not just years of expert training, but real warmth and understanding to every single conversation.

New services, and more counsellors supporting clients monthly - we constantly want to do more.

And behind all this, your generosity has been the quiet but essential force. The whole Sure Steps team says a massive thanks!

That's 2,064 hours of someone saying 'I believe you. I hear you. You matter.' - all thanks to you!

2,064: total number of hours of counselling in 2025 (9% higher than 2024).

DOUBLED: the number of people our Out of Hours Suicide Prevention service has helped since 2019.

82% INCREASE in clients successfully moving on from using our treatment services compared to 2019.

Just joined-up, compassionate care, exactly where it's needed.

Usher's Island has 43 dedicated staff - GPs, nurses, addiction specialists - and 75 beds already in place. We're hoping to reach 100, so no one has to wait for help. Being just a short walk from the city centre, people leaving hospital can carry on their treatment without missing a beat.

Usher's Island really is somewhere special - a team of brilliant, caring people, sharing skills and knowledge to help some of the city's most vulnerable people to get through.
